Possumwood Wildlife, Wildlife Rescue South Coast

This project required the building of a macropod enclosure and shelter shed at the Possumwood Wildlife release property (1800 acres at the Two Thumbs Koala Sanctuary at Peak View).

Apart from roof guttering and connecting a water supply facility this project is now complete. Next to our existing 9 acre macropod enclosure and shed we have constructed a 3 acre, 2.4m high mesh enclosure and 3m x 5m shed. This enclosure is to be used for pre-release wallabies.

The enclosure is made using metal poles and star pickets, five level strand wire and mesh wire netting to 2.4 metres. The shed is made from pine logs, bracing timber and corrugated iron. The shed is 3m x 5m with one side half enclosed.
