In August 2021 I was successful in obtaining a grant from the NWC to construct a large aviary on my property.

There were several delays in sourcing an aviary due to Covid and a small change in the design.

In November 2021 I engaged the Laurieton Men's Shed to construct an aviary to a FAWNA design of modular bolted together panels using heavy duty aviary mesh RHS pipe frame and Zincalume where there is cladding, the panels allow for the aviary to be deconstructed and moved if required.

The first patients were a Tawny Frogmouth then a Kookaburra. This aviary will be a tremendous asset in my work with wildlife, Plantings and other aviary "furniture" will enhance the rehabilitation environment.

Thank you to the NSW Wildlife Council for your grant that greatly increases my capacity for rehabilitation of our injured and orphaned feathered patients.
