Flight Aviary - Gloucester area

FAWNA's expanded membership in the Gloucester/Barrington Tops area has seen the need for a bird "finishing" enclosure available to all volunteers in the region. Using a "tried and true" modular aviary panel design, FAWNA commissioned a local Men's Shed to construct the panels which were picked up and delivered to site.

FAWNA carer, Morgan Dahl, host to this flight enclosure says

"It means a lot to us because before we got this aviary we had nowhere to test the flying ability of in-care birds, we would have to pass them along to someone with a flight aviary for testing which meant extra travel and stress for the birds before release. We now have somewhere to rehabilitate birds with sprained or injured wings where they can rebuild wing strength.

When it is not in use for birds it will be a wonderful aviary to allow possums to grow and prepare for pre-release".
