The grant that I received from NWC to purchase the intensive care humidicrib pictured below makes my life so much easier. It allows me to care for a larger number of very young and premature flying-fox pups. Without this very reliable equipment my nights would consist of broken sleep, I'd need to wake 2 or 3 times a night to check the temperature was correct. My husband made a shelf that is fixed halfway up which allows twice the number of pups to be kept at the constant temperature required to successfully raise very young pups. In other times of the year I lend it to other carers for macropods and possums.
