

NWC- Grant Report 2023

The grant awarded to Coffs Coast Wildlife Sanctuary (CCWS) for \$2100 for a heater and pump for specialised rehab pool that helps provide rehabilitation to over 100 plus marine animals yearly along the North Coast of NSW.

This pool can be used for a variety of species including seabirds, sea turtles and long nosed fur seals.

CCWS works closely with Coffs Harbour Branch WIRES and National Parks and Wildlife Service (NPWS) to assist in the rehabilitation and release of many different marine wildlife. CCWS also assist in data collection for NPWS in their research studies to help assist these species thrive.

The heater will provide warmth during out cooler months of the year, and we can adjust the settings for specialist treatment and care. The circulation pump help provide the animals water movement which helps animals practice nature behaviours and get some physical condition back whilst in care.

With this upgrade, it will help us improve the standard of care for each individual injured marine wildlife that comes into care here at CCWS.
