

NWC- Grant Report 2024

The grant awarded to Coffs Coast Wildlife Sanctuary (CCWS) for rehabilitation pods. These pods help provide rehabilitation to over 100 plus marine animals yearly along the North Coast of NSW.

These pods are versatile and can be used for a variety of species including seabirds, fresh/sea turtles, reptiles and long nosed fur seals.

CCWS works closely with Coffs Harbour Branch WIRES, National Parks and Wildlife Service (NPWS) and FAWNA to assist in the rehabilitation and release of many different marine wildlife. CCWS also assist in data collection for NPWS in their research studies to help assist these species thrive.

This upgrade helps us improve the standard of care, welfare and veterinary care for each individual injured marine wildlife that comes into care here at CCWS.
